JOYFUL SATURDAYS

1. The First and Third Saturdays of every month will be transformed into JOYFUL SATURDAYS, creating a vibrant learning environment for students. These days will be free from conventional academic pressures, allowing students to explore and enhance both academic and non-academic skills through engaging activities.
2. Whereas Second and Fourth Saturdays will be holidays for students of Grades I to V to give them ample time to explore their surroundings and spend more quality time with family. While there will be regular school for grades VI to XII.
3. Pre-primary students will have as usual holiday on all Saturdays.
4. For holistic development of children with the concept of learning without burden, the children will have no bags on some of the Saturdays for the students of Grades I to V aligning with the principles of the National Education Policy (NEP). The initiative has been started to ensure all round development of children. The aim is to give students a platform where they can identify themselves outside of classroom education or develop new skills.
5. Casual Dress on Joyful Saturdays: Some of the Joyful Saturdays will be no-uniform days for the students, allowing them to come in decent casual attire.
6. The students will be engaged with subject enrichment activities and project work, providing a refreshing break from the routine.
