



We are immensely proud to share that Shree Vasishtha Vidhyalaya was selected to participate in the prestigious International Teachers Exchange Program held in Tokyo, Japan, from 30th September to 6th October 2024. Mrs. Meenakshi Khushu, Headmistress of the Primary Section, was nominated from SVV to attend this remarkable event.

The International Teachers Exchange Program is a global initiative aimed at enabling educators from diverse nations to share teaching experiences, exchange best practices, and promote cross-cultural understanding. This year, only 12 educators from across the country were honoured with this unique opportunity, making it a truly distinguished achievement for our institution.

Mrs. Khushu was the only representative from Gujarat, making this achievement even more remarkable.

This exchange program was fully funded by India's Ministry of Education (MoE) in collaboration with Japan's Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT). the program serves as a bridge for enriching education across nations.

This esteemed program, co-organized by the Asia-Pacific Cultural Centre for UNESCO (ACCU) and the Centre for Environment Education, aims to foster cultural exchange, enhance professional growth, and explore innovative teaching methodologies by connecting Indian and Japanese educators and students.




ONGOING CULTURAL EXCHANGE WITH THREE JAPANESE SCHOOLS






EARLY LITERACY SPARKS JOY


NAVRATRI GARBA FEST - CELEBRATING DEVOTION, DANCE & DIVINE ENERGY

LEARNING BY DOING




